TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Responsibility for Damage/Indemnification: Applicant shall defend, hold harmless and indemnify Shingletown Medical Center, their employees and volunteers against all claims, suits, actions, costs, counsel fees, expenses, damages, judgments or decrees by reason of any person's or persons' bodily injury, including death, or property being damaged by negligent acts, willful acts, or errors or omissions of the Applicant, or any of Applicant's subcontractors, or any person employed under said contractor, or under any subcontractors, or in any capacity while participating in the Mountain Art, Antique & Health Faire, except when the loss is caused by the active negligence or intentional wrong doing of Shingletown Medical Center.

Shingletown Medical Center does not assume any responsibility for Applicant's property used at the Mountain Art, Antique & Health Faire and Applicant agrees to take the necessary steps to protect such property.

Americans with Disabilities Act: Applicant understands and agrees to comply with the obligations of Titles II and III of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 in the conduct of the activity, and further agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Shingletown Medical Center from any claims or liability arising out of or by virtue of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Federal Civil Rights Law: The Applicant and his or her representatives, as part of the consideration for the reservation, hereby covenant and agree that no person on the grounds of race, color, or national origin shall be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the conduct of the scheduled activity.
